

## Antimacedonian Congressional Resolutions

On August 3 ,Senator Menendez (NJ) introduced the same resolution in the Senate as Senate Resolution 300

Rep. Bill Pascrell Jr. (NJ) and Rep. Mark E.Souder (iN) spoke against the resolution on the House floor. Rep. Bill Pascrell Jr. (NJ), Rep. Mark E.Souder (IN) and Rep. Bill Mitchell (AZ) also wrote a letter entitled "Resolution Unfairly Criticizes Republic of Macedonia" to all members of the house detailing the inaccuracies of the Resolution and its unfairness.
